Join Salem City Club, on Friday, November 10th, as we welcome **Ed Dover, Professor of Political Science at Western Oregon University**. Professor Dover will speak about the outcomes and significance of the 2006 national and state elections and Oregon ballot measures. Lunch is at 11:45 and the program will begin at noon.

Dover has taught political science for 29 years with the last 19 having been at Western Oregon University. Prior to joining the WOU staff in September 1987 he taught at the University of Wyoming, the University of Colorado, and the University of Tennessee at Martin.

He teaches classes in American government and politics, public policy and administration, presidential and congressional elections, political parties and interest groups, politics and communication, constitutional law, community politics, federalism and intergovernmental relations, congress and the presidency, public personnel administration, public sector labor relations, and governmental budgeting.

American presidential elections have been his primary research area and he has written five books about them since coming to Oregon. The most recent, "Images, Issues, and Attacks: Television Advertising by Incumbents and Challengers in Presidential Elections," was published by Lexington Books in October 2006.

Dover has been active in faculty governance at WOU, serving as president of the faculty union, the WOU Federation of Teachers, from 1989 to 1996, and as the budget analyst for the union collective bargaining team in all contract negotiations since 1991.

He is married to Molly Mayhead who is Professor of Speech at WOU and the co-author of "Women's Political Discourse: a Twenty-First Perspective," published in 2005 by Rowman and Littlefield.
