Guest speaker: Sandra L. Husk, PhD, Superintendent Salem-Keizer Public Schools

Join us Friday, December 15 as we welcome the new superintendent of Salem-Keizer Public Schools – Dr. Sandra L. Husk. In addition to learning about the curriculum direction, we hope to hear about the changes in the management structure, and the goals she has in mind for the Salem-Keizer Public Schools. With the breath of experience gained in other states Dr. Husk may bring a fresh perspective on the financial realities faced by our district based on the state’s funding patterns for public education.

Dr. Sandra L. Husk became the Superintendent of Salem-Keizer Public Schools on July 1, 2006. Prior to assuming this position, Dr. Husk served five years as the Director of Schools for the Clarksville-Montgomery County School System, Clarksville Tennessee, where her leadership produced consistent gains in student achievement and led to the implementation of a district-wide strategic plan with accountability system for all schools and departments that has been adapted as a model statewide.

She previously served as Superintendent of the Mapleton, Colorado School District, Executive Director of Learning Services in Westminster, Colorado; Principal of two schools in Longmont, Colorado; Staff Development Coordinator; Elementary School Counselor; and Teacher. She earned her PhD in Administration, Curriculum & Supervision from the University of Colorado, Denver; her M.A. in Guidance and Counseling from the University of Colorado, Boulder; and her B.S., Elementary Education, University of Georgia, Athens.

We anticipate that Dr. Husk has had time to make an assessment of the district; and we are eager to listen as she provides her insights, thoughts, and comments pertaining to public education in our community.
